Subject: Approval of National Skill Development Council (NSDC)/ National Skill Development Agency (NSDA) for notification of new Qualification Packs (QPs) drafted by Infrastructure Equipment Skill Council (IESC) – Regarding.

Sir,

This is regarding approval of new Qualification Packs (QPs) by the National Skill Development Council (NSDC)/ National Skill Development Agency (NSDA). In this regard, it is stated that ~~the~~ the Infrastructure Equipment Skill Council (IESC) has requested the Department of Heavy Industry (DHI) for a letter of recommendation for seeking the approval of the NSDA for getting the new Qualification Packs drafted by the IESC notified. Now NSDA requires that any further QPs proposals for notification should be recommended by the line / nodal ministries. DHI is the line/ nodal Department for IESC,

2. It may also be mentioned that IESC has the experience of preparing about 30 QPs in the past. Since its inception in 2014, IESC has been able to get 29 Qualifications Packs notified through the NSDA. The said QPs have also been drafted as per the detailed format provided by NSDA. The information pertains to the basics such as:-

1. Role Description: such as A tower crane operator controls crane movements for loading and unloading of materials, equipment, machines, etc. at different heights on the worksite. They control the crane by responding to hand or radio signals by a supervisor or signalman
2. NSQF level : such as 4
3. Minimum Educational Qualifications :such as Class VIII preferably.
4. Maximum Educational Qualifications :such as NA
5. Prerequisite license for Training :such as Certification Training in Tower Crane Operations and worksite safety training preferred
6. Minimum Job Entry Age : such as 18 years

7. Experience: such as Preferably 2 years of experience as signalman in tower crane operations
8. Applicable National Occupational Standards (NOS) such as

1. IES/N0143 Carry out Pre-operation checks on a tower crane
2. IES/N0144 Carry out tower crane operations
3. IES/N0145 Carry out maintenance and troubleshooting of the tower crane
4. IES/N7601 Comply with worksite health and safety guidelines



3. IESC has now drafted the following six (6) new QPs and has requested for the approval of NSDA for getting them notified:

IESC has followed a very detailed process for drafting QPs through expert agency. QPs have also been drafted as per the detailed format provided by NSDA. Quality of these drafts have been found to be satisfactory.

4. In view of the above, being the line/nodal Department of IESC, DHI recommends the six QPs drafted by the IESC, as mentioned in para 3 above, for getting them notified through the National Skill Development Agency (NSDA).
