

MINUTES OF THE SUB-COMMITTEE MEETING FOR CREATION OF QP/NOS FOR JOB ROLES FOR HANDICRAFTS AND CARPET SECTOR HELD ON 21.11.2014 AT HCSSC, EPCH HOUSE, VASANT KUNJ, NEW DELHI

The RFP for creation of QP/NOS for job roles of handicrafts and carpet sector was issued and in response seven agencies submitted their bids. During the 3rd meeting of the Governing body of HCSSC held on 07th October 2014, a Sub-Committee under the Chairmanship of ShriAtulSaluja was formed to negotiate with the agencies and finalize the process of allocation of the jobs to the agency(ies). The sub committee comprising ShriAtulSaluja, Ms. Nitima Mittal and Shri Rajesh Rawat met the agencies on 9th October and negotiated the proposals with the interested bidders. The Sub-Committee finally met on 21st November 2014 and after going through the bids proposes to offer creation of QP/NOS for job roles of handicrafts and carpet sector to the following agencies:

The agencies have been asked to make a presentation to put forward the plan of action and provide occupational map for the crafts allotted to them within 10 days.

The Sub-Committee also took cognizance of the fact that DFID in its presentation in the 3rd meeting of Governing body of HCSSC have volunteered to partner with HCSSC and create entry level QP/NOS for the handicrafts and carpet sector. It was proposed that during the presentation by the agencies the draft occupational map is presented

and based on that the entry level NOSs for some of the major handicrafts and carpet segment may be allocated to DFID.
